### Ermington

Robin Kinstead (minister) and Chris Chandler (warden) from Ermington updated us on the progress of Ermington ministry, including site needs (fencing and Rectory) and new services. An 8:30am service has begun and a new 10am family service is being planned.

### Missions

As we bring on board the Ermington and Indonesian congregations, we will also seek to bring on board the missionaries they have been supporting. This will include 3 CMS missionaries and 1 more AFES missionary.

### Building

Several building works are planned, including the new toilet block on site, a new deck and garage for 8a Clanwilliam St, and major renovation to the Ermington Rectory. More details will follow soon as we gather costs and develop plans.
