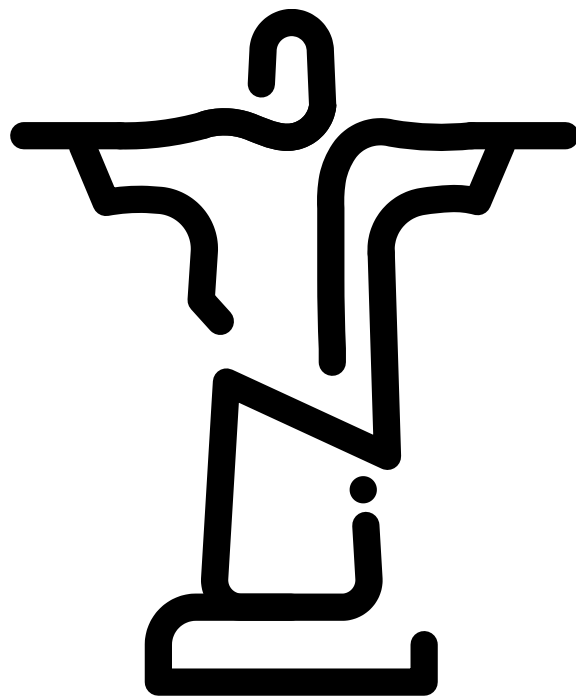

Matthew 26:36-46 | Anna Hoole

Jesus drank the cup of wrath...

“My Father, if it is possible, may this cup be taken from me.” (v39)

“...may your will be done.” (v42)

...so that we could drink the cup of communion

“Then he took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, “Drink from it, all of you. This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.” (v27-28)

Matthew 28 | Bruce Stanley

The women see

Earthquakes, angles and rolling stones.

"Do not be afraid! For I know that you are looking for Jesus who was crucified. He is not here; he has risen," (28:5-6)

The empty tomb VS the risen Jesus

The disciples see

"When they saw him, they worshipped him; but some doubted. "
(Matthew 28:17)

The mission to go and tell
