

## Paper Pretzel Grades 3-6

- 1 Cut out both strips
- 2 Glue on "Overlap center" pieces, then overlap (or tape together on both sides)
- 3 Fold on very long line that crosses both pieces.  
CONTINUE AS SHOWN BELOW. Make both right and left folds at the same time.

### Left Piece

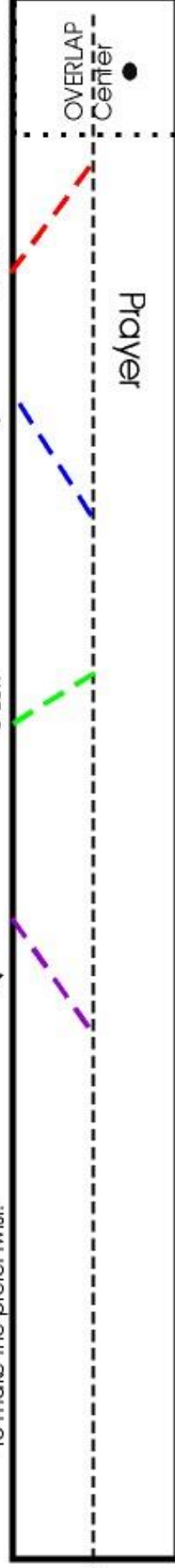
8 Tug and tilt the tail piece until it crosses the other tail to make the pretzel twist.

Fold the line so you see this fold on the outside  
7 Left

Flip over the pretzel so you see the fold line -  
Fold the line inside  
Hide this fold  
6 Left

Flip over the pretzel  
Fold the line inside  
Hide this fold  
5 Left

Fold the line inside  
Hide this fold  
4 Left



Flip over the pretzel  
(if you have not already done so)

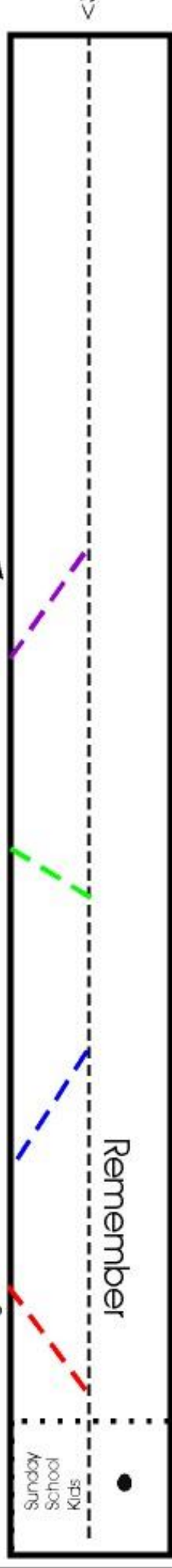
Fold the line inside  
Hide this fold  
5 right

Flip over the pretzel  
(if you have not already done so)  
Fold the line inside  
Hide this fold  
6 Right

Fold the line so you see this fold on the outside  
7 Right

Fold the line inside  
Hide this fold  
4 right

### Right Piece



1. Cut out both right and left strips then put your name on the back edge anywhere. Fold the lower left corner of the paper diagonally until the bottom of the paper meets the right side of the paper.



2. Join and glue the strips
3. (First folds) Fold as shown for both right and left sides. Hide the fold line in the crease.
4. (Second folds) Flip it all over. Fold both right and left sides (hiding the fold line) then flip it back. (End of this step shown)



5. Fold down both ends. (Hide the fold line) You could stop here, but you will make a better pretzel if you continue.
6. The pretzel twist. Fold on the last set of dashed lines. BUT THIS TIME LEAVE IT SO YOU SEE THE DASHES.



7. Crossover the pieces and gently tug and twist until they move into place as shown below.



8. 8. Glue or tape to hold. Trim the tails - a curved cut is best
