# Sermon Outline

## Grace and Law

Bruce Stanley

Deuteronomy 5:1-22, Matthew 5:17-20

- **God's ten point plan**
  - The Lord our God made a covenant with us at Horeb. (Verse 2)
  - It was not with our ancestors that the Lord made this covenant, but with us, with all of us who are alive here today. (verse 3)
  - I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. (verse 6)
- **A Relationship of Love**
- **The law for us today**
  - Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfil them. (Matthew 5:17)
  - For I tell you that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisees and the teachers of the law, you will certainly not enter the kingdom of heaven. (Matthew 5:20)
- **A righteousness for us today**
  - This righteousness is given through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. (Romans 3:22)
  - and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ—the righteousness that comes from God on the basis of faith. (Philippians 3:9)
- **We keep the law, but we depend on Jesus**

## Major Updates

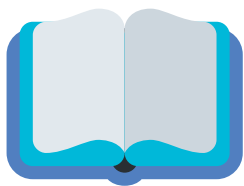
