## Salvation by grace alone

Bruce Stanley

Galatians 2:11-21 & 3:1-9

### Easy to forget grace

- I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the one who called you to live in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel— which is really no gospel at all. - Galatians 1:6-7
- "I now realise how true it is that God does not show favouritism" - Acts 10:34
- So we, too, have put our faith in Christ Jesus that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law, because by the works of the law no one will be justified. - Galatians 2:16

### Easy to add to grace

- Understand, then, that those who have faith are children of Abraham. Scripture foresaw that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, and announced the gospel in advance to Abraham: "All nations will be blessed through you." So those who rely on faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith. - Galatians 3:7-9

### Justification

- "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. ... I do not set aside the grace of God, for if righteousness could be gained through the law, Christ died for nothing!" - Galatians 2:20-21
