Parish Council Update - August

Bible meditation: 1 Corinthians 10:23-27, Philippians 2:3-4

We reflected on how we are to consider the needs of others above ourselves. Applying this to our neighbours and those visiting our church on site or online - we discussed what may make it easier for people to join us and how to ensure we aren't putting any obstacles in the way. The playground and fencing are great examples - both items which will care for people with young children, and we hope will be helpful and useful for members but also anyone in our community walking past.

Thanks Giving Service - October 25

Discussion on ideas for format and how to best have a Thanks Giving service this year in 7 different congregations but also show our unity as a Church.

Plane Tree seat

Discussion on a new large seat which will be constructed around the Plane Tree in the middle of the front area. This will involve 128 slats of timber. And we will encourage people to "buy a seat slat" for \$50 which will cover more than the cost of construction, extra funds will go towards the continuing building work. More details soon!

St Phil's signage

New signage for street fronts was finalised. This will incorporate the new logo and basic contact details. These will be ordered in the coming months. Digital signage was also discussed that will allow us to communicate with the community more effectively for events, etc. However, there are considerable Council restrictions so we are investigating this further to see if it is a possibility.

Finances:

We are currently at 91% of the new budget. However due to current staff vacancies, we have surplus funds which will be used to employ new staff when this can be arranged. Primarily, this involves the appointment of an assistant minister to the English speaking ministries.
